Our commitment

Quiip believes business can drive the systemic change the world desperately needs. Businesses have the solutions, the power, and the influence to build a sustainable, inclusive, prosperous future. We can do that through caring for people and the planet in all decision making, but we also need profitable businesses to do it. Profitable businesses also allow us to redistribute wealth to those doing great work in the non-profit space.

We Pledge to donate a minimum of 1% of revenue every year.

In 2023 we were proud to hit a milestone of \$100,000 donated since 2018.

To quote Yvon Chouinard of Patagonia, "this is not philanthropy, this is the cost of doing business on this planet."

The background

In previous years staff suggested organisations and we voted on these. It was ad-hoc, leading us to formalise our Pledge 1% commitment, and use the SDGs as a framework. We initially focused on five SDGS.

However in 2021/22 given the criticality of the climate emergency, the senior leadership team narrowed our previous focus from five down to two. (However our work focus remained on five areas - we have a B Corp impact business model of Support for Purpose Driven Enterprises.)

We chose to focus on Climate Action (SDG #13) and Reduced Inequalities. (SDG#10) We have a commitment to working with First Nations organisations as part of our Reconciliation Action Plan (RAP). Where possible we choose to support First Nations organisations doing work in the climate space. Two of these orgs are Seed and KKT.
